## Math:

Addition \& Subtraction to 20:

- I can use objects and pictorial models to solve word problems involving joining, separating, and comparing sets within 20 and unknowns as any of the terms in the problem such as $2+4=[\quad]$; $3+[]=7$; and $5=[$ ] -3.
- I can generate and solve problem situations when given a number sentence involving addition or subtraction of numbers within 20.
- I can represent word problems involving addition and subtraction of whole numbers-up to 20 using concrete and pictorial models and number sentences.
- I can determine the unknown whole number in an addition or subtraction equation when the unknown may be any of the three or four terms in the equation.


## Science/SS:

Changes in the Sky

- I can observe and record changes in the appearance of objects in the sky such as clouds, the Moon and stars, including the Sun.
- I can record weather information, including relative temperature, such as hot or cold, clear or cloudy, calm or windy, and rainy or icy.
- I can identify characteristics of the seasons of the year and day and night.
