Reading:

Drama:

- I can notice elements of drama such as characters, setting, dialogue.

Phonics:

OA/OW

- I can decode words with closed syllables; open syllables; VCe syllables; vowel teams, including vowel digraphs and diphthongs; and r-controlled syllables.

Math:

Addition & Subtraction to 20:

- I can use objects and pictorial models to solve word problems involving joining, separating, and comparing sets within 20 and unknowns as any of the terms in the problem such as $2+4=[]$; $3+[-]=7$; and $5-[-]=3$.
- I can generate and solve problem situations when given a number sentence involving addition or subtraction of numbers within 20.
- I can represent word problems involving addition and subtraction of whole numbers up to 20 using concrete and pictorial models and number sentences
- I can determine the unknown whole number in an addition or subtraction equation when the unknown may be any of the three or four terms in the equation

Science/SS:

Texas Symbols

- I can locate places using the four cardinal directions
- I can locate the community, Texas, and the United States on maps and globes.
- I can explain state and national patriotic symbols, including the United States and Texas flags, the Liberty Bell, the Statue of Liberty, and the Alamo.

- I can edit drafts using standard English conventions such as proper nouns.
- I can develop handwriting by printing words, sentences, and answers legibly leaving appropriate spaces between words.
- I can write my opinion and explain it.
