DIFFERENT WAYS TO READ WITH YOUR CHILD

- READ ALOUD Complete a picture walk before reading.
- Discuss/Predict · what will happen.
- Track print as you read.
- Ask questions before, during and after reading.
- Point out details in the illustrations.
- **Use different** voices for the characters.

ECHO READ

Complete a picture walk before readina.

Discuss/ **Predict what** will happen. Track print

as you read. Read a sentence or page. Have your children echo the sentence or

you.

Ask questions as you read.

CHORAL READ

Complete a picture walk before readina. Discuss/

Predict what will happen.

Track print as you read.

Read the story out loud together at the same time.

FOLLOW ME

Complete a picture walk before reading.
